CMSgt Justin G. Jump serves as the Military Personnel Management Officer and Chief, Enlisted Manager, Senior Non-Commissioned Officer, dual status Federal Technician assigned to the Joint Force Headquarters - Air, Camp Fogarty, East Greenwich, RI, Rhode Island Air National Guard. He is responsible for staff assistance, guidance, and direction concerning Air National Guard personnel, administration, training, recruiting, retention, incentive, and budgetary matters, from E-1 to O-8, for The Adjutant General, the Assistant Adjutant General (Air), and Air Staff. Additionally, he is responsible for state level coordination of military personnel programs, developing state level publications, policies, and procedures in support of the 143d Airlift Wing. A principal assistant to the Director of Staff-Air and a liaison between Army Joint Staff, the National Guard Bureau, the Air National Guard Readiness Center, Air Reserve Personnel Center, General Officer-Senior Leadership management, local, state, and federal agencies. An airman leveraging a career of personnel to continuously build professional relationships, enhancing program credibility, and ensuring successful delivery of essential services to fellow Airmen.



Chief Jump is a Senior Personnel Craftsman, 3F091, who joined the Air Force in March 2000. After technical school he was stationed at the 115th Fighter Wing, Mission Support Group, Truax Field Air National Guard Base, WI.

In 2004 he received an honorable discharge after four years of reserve performance in the Air National Guard and moved to Delran, New Jersey. He accepted a Federal Technician position with the 108th Air Refueling Wing, Mission Support Flight, Career Enhancements element, McGuire AFB, NJ as Non-commissioned Officer in charge of relocations. In 2007 he was assigned to the Manpower, Personnel, Recruiting and Services Directorate stationed at Headquarters, Air Reserve Personnel Center, Denver, CO., as a Title 10 Stat Tour participant. During this time, he served in the position of DD Form 214 Service Team Lead, as a Customer Service Counselor Supervisor, and ANG Separation Technician Supervisor. In 2012 he was awarded career status by NGB and was nominated as Personnel Customer Service Manager and assigned as a Retirements Technician Supervisor.
